

# Privacy Policy

## 1. General Information

We appreciate your interest in our company. The protection of your personal data is of particular importance to the management of **Mevas GmbH & Co. KG**. The use of our website is generally possible without providing any personal data. However, if you make use of specific services offered by our company via the website, processing of personal data may become necessary. Where no statutory legal basis exists for such processing, we will obtain the consent of the data subject.

Personal data (such as name, address, email address, or telephone number) is processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the applicable German data protection laws. With this privacy policy, we inform the public about the type, scope, and purpose of the collection, use, and processing of personal data and explain the rights of data subjects.

## 3. Definitions

This privacy policy uses the terms defined by the GDPR. Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. A data subject is any natural person whose personal data is processed. Processing means any operation performed on personal data, such as collection, storage, use, or deletion.

## 4. Cookies

Our website is based on the content management system **WordPress** and uses cookies. Cookies are text files that are stored on your device and help make the website more user-friendly, effective, and secure.

WordPress may set cookies to make it easier for returning visitors to enter data, in particular when using contact forms. These cookies do not create personal user profiles and **do not allow any conclusions to be drawn about specific individuals**.

In addition, we use the plugin **Google Site Kit**, which integrates services provided by Google (such as Google Analytics, Search Console, or similar statistical services). In this context, it is possible that Google processes personal data and stores cookies on your device. This may include IP addresses, device information, or usage data.

The processing is carried out on the basis of Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR (consent) or Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR (legitimate interest in analyzing and optimizing our website).

You can prevent the storage of cookies at any time via the settings of your browser or delete cookies that have already been stored. Please note that disabling cookies may limit the functionality of the website.

## 5. Collection of General Data and Log Files

When accessing our website, information is automatically stored in so-called server log files. This information may include browser type and version, operating system used, IP address, date and time of access, and similar technical data. This data is analyzed anonymously to ensure the operation and security of the website. It is not merged with other personal data.

## 6. Contact

If you contact us by email or via a contact form, the personal data you provide will be stored solely for the purpose of processing your inquiry and will not be passed on to third parties.

## 7. Rights of Data Subjects

Data subjects have the following rights in particular:

- Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
- Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR)
- Right to withdraw consent at any time (Art. 7(3) GDPR)
- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

To exercise your rights, you may contact us at any time.

## 8. Legal Basis for Processing

Personal data is processed on the basis of Art. 6(1) GDPR, in particular:

- Consent (lit. a)
- Performance of a contract or pre-contractual measures (lit. b)
- Compliance with a legal obligation (lit. c)

- Legitimate interests (lit. f)

## 9. Storage Period

Personal data is stored only for as long as necessary to fulfill the respective purpose or as required by statutory retention periods. After expiry of these periods, the data is routinely deleted.

## 10. Automated Decision-Making

We do not use automated decision-making or profiling.
